Recording phone calls is a large legal grey area because it is considered illegal in most locations, unless you get the permission of all parties involved, or if there is an audible beep to indicate that everyone can hear clearly. Due to the legal implications, it is highly unlikely that Apple will ever record a recording feature for recording conversations built directly into iOS itself. However, there are some third-party apps that can help you record phone calls, which is useful when conducting phone interviews or other important calls. Here are some of the best phone recording apps we've found on the App Store. Call recording by NoNotes If you often end up in many business calls and need to record them for later, try call recording by NoNotes. The app just needs to know your phone number that you're going to use, an email, and then you create a six-digit numeric pin. Once these are set up, just sign in. You now record and transcribe incoming or outgoing calls, where the files can be shared via email or other cloud services. The app is free to download and use, giving you 20 minutes of recordings and transcriptions per month. You can buy more if needed through in-app purchases. Free with in-app purchases - Download Now TapeACall Pro: Call Recorder TapeACall Pro is another great choice for those times when you need to record a phone call (with permission, of course). With this app, all you have to do is start the app while you're on the phone (let the other party know you're recording). When you start TapeACall, put the call on hold and call their recording line. As soon as the line responds, tap the merge button to make a three-way conversation between your other caller and tapeacall recording rule (three-way meetings are required with your provider). Recording an outgoing call is also easy: press the recording button to choose their recording line, and then tap Add Call to call the person you want to record, and then press Merge when they reply. All recordings with TapeACall can be downloaded to your computer, and the app supports unlimited recordings. There is an optional subscription service that offers even more features, such as transcriptions. \$11 with in-app purchases - Download Now Call Recorder - IntCall If you want a call recording app that's flexible with the number of withdrawals you need at any given time, Call Recorder - IntCall is a fun one to consider. The WhatsApp Calling feature appeared on Android devices late last month. It is similar to FaceTime Audio and Skype on iOS and data charges are likely to apply if the service is used on mobile data. Record conversations with Google Voice Many Android users have installed the Google Voice app on their phone, making it easy to record phone calls with a Google Voice account. Not only that, but the app you record your calls for free. At least a few phone calls. If you choose Google Voice, you only record incoming calls. First, you need a Google Voice account. If you don't have one, go to the Google Voice website and follow the on-screen instructions. Then, once your account is set up, you need to enable the recording on your account, which is relatively easy to do. Step 1: Navigate to the Google Voice home page. Record conversations with a third-party app There are many apps designed to record calls on your Android phone, although some of them work better than others. We tested a few of them to see how they worked, but before diving into our suggestions, suggestions, is something to keep in mind. Most of these apps rely solely on your microphone to record both incoming and outgoing audio, which means that conversations that aren't recorded while on the speaker are a little quiet. That said, here are a few of the better recording apps we've come across. You also set up the app to store recordings in various cloud services, such as Google Drive and Dropbox. Android Call Recorder - ACR Another good call recording app in the Google Play Store right now is ACR. There are freemium and premium versions of the app; the latter costs \$4 and gets rid of ads. The app is simple and looks good. It automatically records and stores calls based on a phone number and displays them in an organized manner. In addition, the formats of recordings may vary from M4As, MP3s, WAV's and MP4s, among others. The app also automatically deletes old recordings, but if you don't want this to happen, you mark a recording as important. Best of all, if you don't want to record calls from a particular number, you're ruling out recording. You also protect recordings with a password so that no one else can access them. To upload your recordings to a cloud service, ACR is compatible with popular options like Google Drive, Dropbox, WebDAV, and OneDrive. One last thing to keep in mind is that this app doesn't record Wi-Fi or VoIP calls – mobile only. That means that if you're using the Google Fi network, which makes calls over Wi-Fi, you'll need to manually turn off Wi-Fi to record the call. Android Recording calls with an external recorder There is one last way to record a phone call, but it is a bit complicated and potentially pricey. Instead of using an app, you purchase a special phone recorder and connect it to your smartphone's 3.5mm jack. If your smartphone doesn't have one, you don't use this method. There are a few good options for phone recorders out there, such as the Fivoice Call Recording Earphone and the RecorderGear PR200. Both recorders are easy to use, and they cost between \$34 and \$110. While that's more expensive than the apps above, they're easier to use and, possibly, more reliable.
